# Off-Site Photos Checklist

## Location

- ☐ Choose a location close to your venue (limit travel time)
- ☐ Check accessibility for vehicles and people
- ☐ Consider a pre-wedding shoot to save time on the day

## Timing and Weather

- ☐ Golden hour lighting is before sunset, check with your photographer for best timing on your wedding date
- ☐ Allow time for travel, drinks, and short breaks
- ☐ Share your plan with photographer and vendors
- ☐ Add buffer time to avoid rushing

## Comfort

- ☐ Pack wraps or jackets for the wedding party
- ☐ Bring umbrellas, just in case!
- ☐ Bring flat shoes for walking between shots
- ☐ Have insect repellent and tissues handy
- ☐ Keep water and snacks within reach

## Transport and Refreshments

- ☐ Decide who's coming off-site: just you or the whole crew
- ☐ Arrange enough vehicles and drivers
- ☐ Pack refreshments and water
- ☐ Ask your caterer to prep a small snack hamper
- ☐ Check if your photographer / videographer wants some snacks too!

## Flexibility

- ☐ Have 1–2 backup photo locations / ideas
- ☐ Discuss options with your photographer ahead of time
- ☐ Stay open to changing locations if needed
